HAMLET OF ENTERPRISE BY-LAW #2007-08

Being a by-law of the Hamlet of Enterprise in the Northwest Territories, pursuant to the provisions of the *Hamlets Act*, R.S.N.W.T., 2003 section 19.

WHEREAS the Hamlet of Enterprise desire to stagger the terms of office of Councillors:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Hamlet of Enterprise, at a meeting, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1 **Short Title**

This by-law may be cited as the "**The Staggered Term Bylaw**":

2 The Hamlet of Enterprise shall hold general elections annually

3 One half of the Council shall be elected at each general election for a two year term.

4 For the first election following the approval of this Bylaw, Councillors elected shall hold office as follows:

- a. Half of the successful candidates who receive the highest number of votes hold office for the full term of office;
- b. The balance of the successful candidates holds office for a one year term less than the full term of office.
- c. The Mayor shall be elected to a two year term.

5 This Bylaw shall come into effect upon receiving third and final reading.

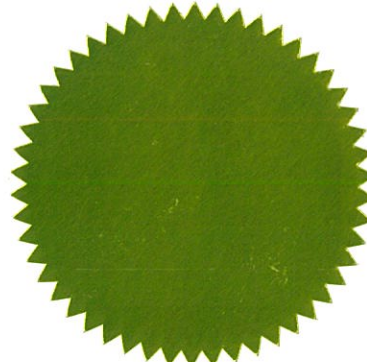


I wish to acknowledge receipt of Bylaws # 2007-5, 2007-07 and 2007-08 on behalf of the Minister and in compliance with section 78(2) of the *Hamlets Act*. I note in Bylaw #2007-08 some errors. The bylaw states "Subject to Section 14(3) and Section 19(1) of the Hamlet Act, the term of Office of Community Councillor may be reduced to six (6)." First, I assume the bylaw meant to say the number, not the term, may be reduced to six. Second, this change is not done by bylaw, but by Ministerial Order. It is incorrect to include this here. Similarly, it is incorrect to refer to 3 councillors when discussing staggered terms.

I also note that the bylaw says that three councillors are elected for a two year terms and three are elected for one year terms. I think the bylaw meant to say that the council is adopting staggered terms, that at the first election one half would be elected for a two year term and one half would be elected for a one year term. All following elections would be for two year terms.

I note that the copies of the bylaws #2007-07 and #2007-08 I received do not contain the Mayor's signature.
