**HAMLET OF ENTERPRISE
BY-LAW NO. 2022-116**

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise in the Northwest Territories authorizing the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise to acquire real property by way of purchase, pursuant to section 57 of the *Hamlets Act*, S.N.W.T.2003, C-22.

Whereas it is deemed necessary and in the public interest that the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise in the Northwest Territories to acquire the land described hereunder for the orderly development of property;


Now therefore be it resolved, that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise, at a duly assembled meeting, enact as follows:

The Mayor and Senior Administrative Officer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise to acquire from the **Government of the Northwest Territories Department of Lands** for the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) the land described hereunder:

The whole of **Lot 18, Block 2** in the Hamlet of Enterprise in the Northwest Territories according to the Plan of Survey filed in the Land Titles Office under Number **318** upon the following terms and conditions:

That this by-law shall come into effect upon the day of final passage thereof,
