BYLAW NUMBER 65

A Bylaw of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise, in the Northwest Territories, providing for the entering into of an electrical distribution franchise agreement between the Hamlet of Enterprise and Northland Utilities (NWT) Limited, pursuant to the provisions of the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22.

WHEREAS the Hamlet of Enterprise deems it in the public interest to grant of a public utility franchise for the distribution of electric energy in the Hamlet of Enterprise;

AND WHEREAS Council has been provided a draft of the proposed franchise agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF ENTERPRISE enacts as follows:

1. CITATION

1. This by-law may be cited as the "NORTHLAND UTILITIES (NWT) LIMITED, ELECTRICAL DISTRIBUTION FRANCHISE AGREEMENT BYLAW."

2. PURPOSE

1. The Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise authorizes entering into a franchise agreement with Northland Utilities (NWT) Limited for the distribution of electrical energy within the municipality of the Hamlet of Enterprise, such agreement to be substantially in the form of the draft form of agreement provided to Council ("the Franchise Agreement").
2. The Mayor and Senior Administrative Officer are hereby authorized to execute the Franchise Agreement on behalf of the Municipal Corporation of Hamlet of Enterprise.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE

1. This by-law will come into effect upon receiving Third and Final Reading.
