HAMLET OF ENTERPRISE

BYLAW NUMBER 66

A bylaw of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise in the Northwest Territories authorizing the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise to dispose of real property by way of bylaw, pursuant to the provisions of the *Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22, s. 56*.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and in the public interest that the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise dispose of the land described hereunder for the orderly development of property,

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE HAMLET OF ENTERPRISE, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

1. The Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise be and is hereby authorized to dispose of its fee simple interest in:

LOT 4
BLOCK 13
PLAN 4603
ENTERPRISE

to Aurora Wood Pellets Ltd. for the sum of two hundred and thirty five thousand dollars (\$235,000).

2. The sale of the property to Aurora Wood Pellets Ltd., at a purchase price of \$235,000, subject to the terms and conditions contained in a draft Purchase Agreement provided to Council, be and is hereby approved.
3. That the Mayor and Senior Administrative Officer of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise, or lawful deputy of either of them, are hereby authorized in the name and on the behalf of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise, to execute the purchase agreement, with such minor changes as may be approved by the Mayor and Senior Administrative Officer, Resolution 2015-326, and all other documents that may be necessary to give effect to this by-law and to affix thereto the corporate seal of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise.
4. This Bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading.
